

# **Competition Rules and Format**



**Number of holes.** The competition shall be over 18 holes.

**The Competition** will be determined by Stableford scoring against the normal Par of the course from the yellow, red and green tees.

#### **Tees**

Players aged 12/13 and any younger competitor who wishes to qualify for a scratch prize should play from the normal men's (yellow) and ladies (red) tees.

Players aged 11 and under may opt to play off forward tees however, if they do so, they will be ineligible for the main title or for the other scratch prizes.

### **Eligibility**

The Competition is open to boys and girls who are aged 8 - 13 on the day of the competition with or without an official handicap.

### **Competitions**

All players will be competing in three competitions simultaneously, as before – scratch, handicap (full allowance) and age group. Where a player does not have an official handicap he/she shall be allocated an age based handicap, as follows.

### Scoring

Players must record their gross scores and nett Stableford scores. The organisers shall calculate the scratch Stableford score.

**Caddies** – are not permitted.

#### There are 12 Prizes

No player shall be awarded more than one prize.

### The Moortown Junior Master 2014:

The winner shall be the player with the best scratch stableford score.

# 1<sup>st\*</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Scratch Boys

(must have played off the yellow tees).

# 1<sup>st\*</sup> Scratch Girl

(must have played off the red tees)

\* One of the above will win the Junior I

\* One of the above will win the Junior Master prize.

# 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Handicap Boys

(golf handicap or age based as above)

**Age Group Prizes** based on best handicap scores

Players aged 8 & 9

Players aged 10 & 11

Players aged 12 & 13

(who have not already won a prize above).

## The Result

In the event of a tie, the result will be decided by a countback on the back 9 - then 6, 3, and last hole (then last 12 & 15).

If, due to poor weather, play is cancelled the result will stand provided 50% of the field have completed their rounds.

The decision of the organisers on any matters arising shall be final.

On Arrival Please register in the Professional Shop at least 30 minutes before

your tee time.

Club House Facilities are available to all competitors, family, helpers and friends.

The Mixed Lounge, TV ROOM and Dining Room only will be used for the event and smart relaxed dress (see the dress rules) is permissible all

day in these areas including the prize giving.

The MacKenzie Room and Billiards Room are out-of-bounds for the

day.

Warm-Up Facilities We recommend that all players take a little time to warm up on our

practice tee which will open at 8.00am. Each player will be provided with a complimentary basket of balls and additional baskets can be

purchased from the professional at £1each.

30 Minutes Before Tee

Time

You will be allocated a match Steward who will meet you at the first

tee and then accompany and assist you during your round.

**Competition Tees** All play will commence from the 1<sup>st</sup> Tee. Tees will be as follows:-

Boys aged 8 & 9 Green
Boys aged 10 & 11 Red
Boys aged 12 & 13 Yellow
Girls aged 11 & under Green
Girls aged 12 & 13 Red

However, any boy or girl aged 11 or under who wishes to qualify for the Junior Masters and Scratch Prizes should play from the Yellow or Red Tees respectively. Please advise of this when registering and you

will be given the appropriate card.

Halfway House Snack The Halfway House will be open to provide Soft Drinks, Chocolate Bars

and hot beverages which need to be paid for with cash please.

After Your Round Check your card with the playing partner who is marking it and <u>ask</u>

 $\underline{\text{\bf them to sign it}}.$  Then check it again with your Match Steward before

handing it to them to submit to the organisers on your behalf.

**Afternoon/Evening Meal** In the dining room. A Light Lunch will be provided free for players

following their round. This will comprise Sausage, Chips and Beans or a Burger and Chips. Please indicate before teeing off any special
